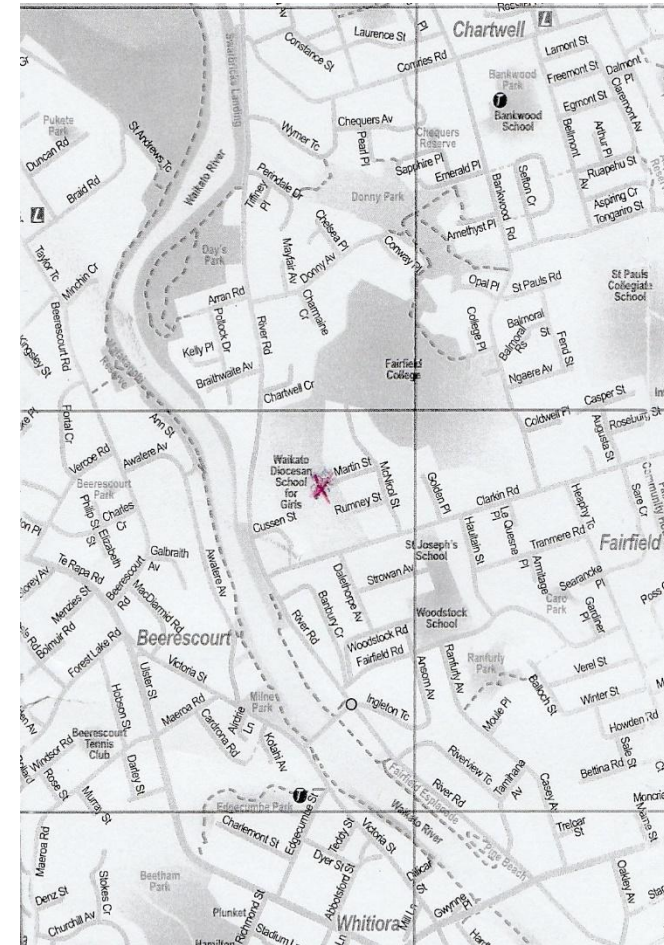

CLASS SELECTION GUIDE

Elementary:

For first and second year dancers who understand basic steps and formations and wish to improve their dancing technique. The class is geared towards adults; however, young dancers over 12 years of age who are disciplined enough to share a class with adults are welcome.

Mainstream:

For dancers who have moved beyond Elementary and are dancing competently. Working on more advanced formations and refining steps.

Advanced:

This class will be covering interesting dances with emphasis on formations and technique.

While we are not holding JAM classes this year, young dancers from about 12 years upwards are welcome to join any class on the recommendation of their regular tutor.
